1. Organizer

In conjunction with the 40th Anniversary of Bangladesh-Japan Diplomatic Relationship and in the month of “Ekushey February”, the Japanese Universities Alumni Association in Bangladesh (JUAAB) will organize the event with kind support of the Japan Foundation, the Embassy of Japan in Bangladesh and the Japanese Association in Dhaka.

3. Eligibility of the Participants/Contestants

a) For the Japanese Speech Contest:

(1) Must be a citizen of Bangladesh residing in Bangladesh

(2) Must be above 18 years of age

(3) If stayed in Japan, the duration of stay at a stretch must not be above three months

(4) Neither of the parents should be a Japanese

b) For Bengali Speech Contest:

(1) Must be a citizen of Japan residing in Bangladesh

(2) Must be above 18 years of age

(3) The total duration of stay in Bangladesh must not be above 5 (five) years

(4) Neither of the parents should be a Bangladeshi

4. Time Limit for Speech and the Number of Contestants

a) The time limit for a speech shall be 5 (five) minutes.

- b) The number of contestants shall be limited to 15 (fifteen) for Japanese Speech Contest and 10 (ten) for Bengali Speech Contest.

5. Topic for Speech

A contestant (for both Japanese and Bengali Speech Contests) will select either of the following two topics:

- a) Future Relationship between Bangladesh & Japan.
- b) The good things to learn from Japan/Bangladesh.

6. Certificate and Prize

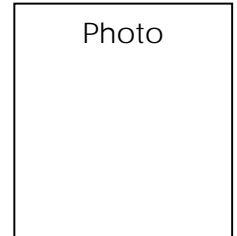
- a) The “Certificate of Participation” and gifts donated by different organizations will be given to each final contestant.
- b) Crests will be given to the 1st/2nd/3rd Prize Winners of both Japanese and Bengali Speech Contests.
- c) The 1st and 2nd prize winners of the Japanese Speech Contest will be recommended by JUAAB for participation (on full invitation) in the “SAFJUAA Speech Contest in Japanese Language” to be held in Kathmandu, Nepal in March 2012.

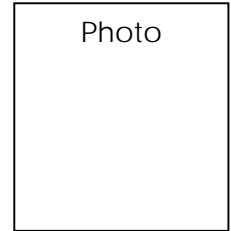
