<u>Relief</u> Supplies from Bangladesh arrived in Japan

On Thursday, March 31, 2011, relief materials (blankets, rubber boots and rubber gloves) supplied by the Government of Bangladesh has arrived at Narita Airport, Japan.

2,000 blankets will be distributed to the people affected by the disaster and now taking refuge in the place away from their home town. 500 rubber boots and 1,000 rubber gloves will be dispatched to the areas affected by the disaster. These supplies will be very useful for the devastated people in the respective areas to recover their home.

Bangladeshi nationals who are living in Japan also are participating in voluntary various activities. such providing as free hotel accommodation and hot meals to the affected people.

On behalf of the Government and the people of Japan, the Embassy of Japan deeply appreciates the cooperation extended by the Government and the people of Bangladesh.
