Currently, I am working at Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Agricultural Univeristy as an Associate Professor under the Department of Agricultural Engineering. In October 2014, I was selected as a MEXT Scholar through the University Recommendation. The Graduate School of Agriculture in Hokkaido University was offered a Special English Program for MS and PhD from the foreign students. Under this program, I got a chance for doing research on agricultural robotics in the laboratory of Vehicle Robotics for three and half years.

# Applying for MEXT

When I was an under graduate student at Bangladesh Agricultural University, I knew most of our teachers have finished their post-graduation from Japan under this MEXT. Particularly, I was spent wonderful time before the end of my PhD because that time my beloved family was with mine. I visited at Oakanai city with them and some brothers, and this tour was very interesting. Honestly, I would like to say that my life was so smooth and trouble free only for the kindness of Japanese people.

After then I was waiting to back my mother land. As I was assistant professor at Shahjalal University of Science and Technology before going to Japan, I joined again to that university. After a month I promoted to associate professor. Recently, I joined at Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Agricultural University. Now, I am enjoying my time with my work, and with my beloved family, dear friends, brothers and colleagues. Indeed, as a MEXT scholar not only I achieved a degree but also I got some words in my lives that are discipline, enthusiastic, patient, positive thinking and confidence.
